The standability of Goliath can be lessened in situations with higher fertility and should probably be harvested for forage in those cases to prevent lodging issues. Goliath has become one of the most widely planted oat varieties across Kansas and other neighboring areas because of its tremendous forage potential. It is a late maturing variety, so early heat could cause issues some years in forage or grain yield capabilities.
