Lavina Spring Barley was developed by Montana State University as a forage barley line. It has shown to be widely adapted to Kansas and south for early spring plantings of forage and cover crop blends. It has great forage yield potential and reaches harvest faster than spring oats used for a forage crop in the region. Lavina is an excellent product for haying and good for silage. This variety should not be planted in the fall unless it is used in a cover crop blend intended for freezing out for standing residue over the winter.
